

Blueberries Crop Hail Estimate

Crop Hail covers loss due to hail. It will not cover wind loss in the absence of hail. Plants must be physically hit by hail and show signs of cutoffs or lesions. Crop Hail also covers fire and perils in transit to first place of storage or processing (within 50 miles). Crop hail for blueberries has a 15% deductible. You can choose any whole dollar amount of coverage per acre up to the limit of \$1000 per acre for blueberries.

Georgia Farmers agency advises farmers to use their costs of production to help decide a minimum amount of coverage per acre they choose for their crop hail plan. The UGA extension office estimates costs of production for many crops grown in Georgia and is a good source if you don't know your own costs of production.
